Honourees can be anyone who has actively served Canada or its allies in any capacity past or present. The honouree must have some connection to Norquay and district (born here, grew up or lived here, or is related to a current resident).

This Banner Project is open to anyone wishing to honour a veteran. If you do not know of anyone personally but still want to sponsor a banner, we will help you find a local veteran.

To participate in the Norquay Banner Project, submit this application form, along with a cheque or e-transfer of \$200.00 and a high resolution 5" x 7" portrait-style photograph (headshot and uniform preferred). Please submit the photo with identification written on the back. Hard copies pictures are preferred and are the best image for the banner, a digital photo in pdf or similar format of 300dpi or better high resolution will work if a paper copy is not available. The photograph can be mailed to the address at the bottom of the application form and will be returned. Cheques are payable to: Norquay Banner Project. We also accept e-transfers.

Please include a typed 100-word biography that will be shared on our town website.

Applications will be taken on a first-come, first-served basis. We have posts to hang a maximum of 40 banners. Honouring a member will cover the placement of a banner for up to three years as long as it remains in good repair. After three years, or when normal wear and tear prevents its display, you will have the option to replace it.
