ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS • US Citizen or Permanent Resident • Residents with an address in our service area, Texas address • Planning to enroll in an accredited college/university or vocational/community college as full-time student • Cumulative GPA of at least 2.5 (as calculated on a 4.0 scale) •

ALL APPLICANTS SHOULD PROVIDE THE FOLLOWING: • Completed Application • Two Letters of Recommendation: One from a schoolteacher/official (Guidance Counselor, Principal, etc.), one from a community leader not affiliated with your school (Pastor, Volunteer Organization, Girl Scout leader, Employer/Supervisor, etc.). Letters of Recommendation must be signed and include recommender's title (original signature and dated – pen and ink). Electronic signatures will not be accepted. Recommendations should be from persons who can attest to your character, interpersonal relationships, personal attributes, and academic achievements. They should not be written by family members. • Wallet-size photo (appropriate for business use) • Letter of Acceptance from college/university • Essay • Official Transcript (must include GPA, Rank).
