Message from the Headteacher

As salaamu alaikum wa Rahmatullahi wa barakhatahu,

It's an old adage that two school days are never the same and although Head teachers have to deal with all sorts of unlikely matters, risks to security as a result of unlawful occupation of land is a new one. Many thanks to all the parents who have sent supportive messages in this regard. It is likely that the neighbouring field will be empty by the beginning of next week Insha'Allah. I should stress that I have worked with traveller families in the past and they simply have a lifestyle and view of land ownership which is different to that of the majority of us and is worthy of respect. We will continue to adopt the same practices with regard to the front gate as I feel that a presence there makes the school and therefore the children more secure from any risks posed as a result of political uncertainty.

Summer term is usually the busiest term of all, for school staff and this term will be no exception. In June, our Year 4 children will complete their multiplication tables test and our Year 1 children will have their phonics screening check. I am sure that they have been well prepared for these by their teachers and parents.

I am delighted to advise that our football team had a successful afternoon at the Avanti school last week, winning 2-1 against a Year 6 team away from home! Coach Jordan spoke to me of his pride in the way that the team conducted itself, showing the very best of manners, excellent sportsmanship and embracing humility in their success. It was wonderful to hear how they took their Hujjat value away with them as wonderful examples of how to behave. We are attending a competitive athletics event next week and I am sure that all participants will also do us proud. I am generally very happy with the children's behaviour and attitudes across the school this year and we are preparing to consign the classroom behaviour chart to history as it has achieved its purpose and we are beginning to see the school values shine through.

We have seen some wonderful assemblies over the past few weeks. The quality of what we are seeing seems to improve each year. I am always amazed with the children's Arabic during assemblies, their confident singing and the research that they do to ensure that the assembly is informative. Well done to all the children in Al Wadood, As Shakoor, Ar Raooof and Al Khaaliq for their lovely assemblies this term.

We decided to postpone our Information Evening earlier this week in the light of the new security concerns but we would urge as many parents as possible to attend the re-scheduled event (details will be provided). 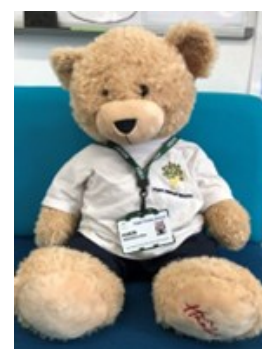
'Pupils of the Week' Achievements
