### Message from the Headteacher

Asalaam Alaikum parents and carers,

I pray that you are all well and that Ramdhan has been fruitful and rewarding so far. We are now in the final ten days and may Allah (SWT) grant us all another opportunity to be here to celebrate another Ramadhan next year, Insha'Allah.

I should start with an apology for any confusion that might have been caused by the error in one of my emails that stated that we would hold soft starts on the mornings of the 24th and 28th March. **There will be soft start on the morning of Monday the 24th and Thursday 27th March.** Children should come to school at the usual time but there will be an opportunity to bring them to school between 10:00am and 10:30 am on each of these mornings. Please bring the children to the Key Stage 2 playground or to the entrance of the Key Stage 1/ Reception class. If your children are unwell, you should notify the School Office as usual.

Last week, we held our class pastoral days to enable our teachers to discuss each child's progress with them directly, their general wellbeing and also any concerns that they may have been having around friendships. This week we saw the beginning of end of term NFER testing which we use as a tool to help inform our end of term assessments. The tests themselves do not dictate the attainment outcome for each child as the teacher judgements that are made by the class teacher over the course of the term form the basis of their overall judgement. Next week, Mrs. Saad and myself will meet with all of our teachers to ensure that the judgements are accurate. You will have an opportunity to discuss the overall judgements with the teachers at parent's evening on the 2nd/3rd April. Please note that this will be a face to face meeting, as requested by many parents in our earlier surveys.

I mentioned some of our planned Ramadhan activities in my last newsletter but I would like to thank the children for some of their amazing entries for the Qu'ranic art projects. The standard of all the entries was very high and it was wonderful to see such a fantastic effort being made by the children. Many thanks to Mrs. Jessa for arranging this and the Eid gifts appeal for children in local hospitals.

I would like to thank our fantastic FOHPS committee for arranging a lovely iftaar and talent show event earlier this week. It was well attended and everything ran very smoothly.

Finally, I would like to thank the parents of a significant proportion of our children who have managed 100% attendance (or very nearly 100% so far this year). It would be amazing if this could be maintained until the end of summer term!

Please enjoy the final ten days of Ramadhan and may Allah (SWT) reward you for all your devotions and deeds.
