### Message from the Headteacher

Asalaam Alaikum parents and carers,

This first half of term has passed by so speedily that it's hard to imagine that one sixth of the school year is already complete.

Our Reception teachers have been busy with their Reception Baseline Assessments and I would like to thank Mrs. Al-Sader and Mrs. Aksouh for their hard work in this regard. The assessments are used as a baseline to track a child's progress from the beginning of Reception all the way through to Year 6.

I am delighted to report that we have begun to take part in some competitive sport this term with six of our children taking part in and performing very well in a Harrow school's badminton competition. Just after half term, our first football team will be "playing away from home" at the Hive. I am sure that they will give of their best Insha'Allah. In the meantime some of our children, chosen at random will visit Wembley stadium over half term to watch the England v Australia rugby match.

Year 3 visited the Chiltern Open Air Museum last week to enhance and enrich their learning around the stone age and the bronze age. The feedback has been outstanding and I was hugely impressed with the "axes" they made during their visit. Year 2 visited Winsor Castle to enrich their learning about British Monarchs. Again, an enjoyable and valuable learning opportunity was enjoyed by all. Once again, arrangements for our children to enter The Bebras Challenge will commence. The challenge is delivered in partnership with Oxford University and introduces computational thinking to students worldwide. The challenge will take place in school (more information to follow). Many thanks to Mrs. Rizvi, who is acting Computing lead during the period of Mrs. Somji's maternity leave. I am hoping that we can take part in another debating competition, particularly as we now have LAMDA certificated public speakers in the school.

I have also asked teachers to use google classroom to provide you with details of the upcoming BBC 500 words competition which is open to children from 5-11 and encourages them to simply write a story they would love to read in under 500 words. The competition runs independently from the school and might be a lovely half-term activity. A huge thank you to all our parents who are helping with the walking bus scheme and those who are helping to maintain better relations with our neighbours by assisting at various parking areas around the school.
