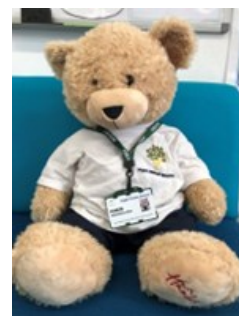
## 'Pupils of the Week' Achievements
