Message from the Headteacher

A very warm welcome back to every member of our school community! I would like to start by thanking all of our parents for their amazing show of appreciation for our staff with all your lovely gifts and cards. Your generosity and kindness is overwhelming and we will do all we can to be worthy of your trust this year. A special thank you for the wonderful poem put together by some of our parents—you know who you are! I am delighted to welcome Mrs. Emini as Al-Adl teacher, science lead and Key Stage 2 phase lead, Ms Hassan as Al-Wadood class teacher and Sports/Outdoor Areas lead, Mrs. Shinwari, Ms. Marsida, Ms Al Badawi as TA's and Ms Reid in the Office to our ranks.

We have been working hard to develop our school much further this year and I am confident that this can be achieved Insha'Allah with your continued support. This term, we are developing our outdoor areas including the Key Stage 1 playground and the nature area outside of Key Stage 1 and I am pleased to see that staff are already taking advantage of these spaces. We would like to make one more collective effort to finish the painting and other jobs to complete the fantastic work that was done by our parent volunteers last summer. Parents are really encouraged to come and help us on Sunday 28th September to finish everything. The school gates will be open from 9:30am and will be closed at 5:00pm. Children are, of course, very welcome. I am also delighted to be able to confirm that we now have a fantastic new art/DT room (see the pictures on next page). A huge thank you to all the parents that have contributed to funding of this space at various events and to members of FOHPS (Friends of Hujjat Primary School) for your sterling efforts in helping to bring this about.

Another area that we will be developing is curriculum enrichment for our children. Our class teachers and support staff have very kindly agreed to provide the children with a more rounded and exciting school experience by running weekly after school clubs. These include "Hujjat Times", "Messy Hands" and "Comic Creations" amongst many other things. It's all very cryptic but refer to the clubs information already sent out. We will be running the walking Club until half term, but will then take a pause with the change in weather until Spring Term. Please look out for further information. Some of you may be aware that Ofsted have recently changed their inspection framework and school attendance is now a discreet area of scrutiny. We are still behind our target of reaching the national average for attendance but I am sure that we can achieve this Insha'Allah. Please accept my apologies for the problems that some of you experienced regarding the change in gate opening times. We thought about it carefully and we do hope that the changes have alleviated things for you. As mentioned in my email, the reason for the change was the urgent need to improve punctuality so that lessons can start on time and that all children benefit from a full day at school.
