**Message from the Headteacher**

It seems hard to believe that we are already moving towards half term so soon but I believe that our staff and children have got off to a great start to the year, Masha'Allah.

You have all received many emails from me regarding parking in recent weeks. I think it is important for everyone to understand the rationale for all of this and I will provide a full explanation in an email which should be with you today, Insha'Allah. From Monday you should see the school wardens, who have kindly volunteered to help the school, in their hi vis jackets. You may also be aware that one of our parents has organised a "walk in bus trial" for children in Year 2 and we will see if it is possible to expand this very helpful scheme, in which parents arrange to drop their child at a pre-agreed meeting point so that the parent volunteer can take the group into school.

October is Black History Month and I would like to thank our History lead, S. Aksouh for arranging lots of fun activities for the children. We enjoyed her assembly, which gave children an insight into the history of the Black History project and the life and works of the Kenyan environmentalist Wangari Maathi and Betty Campbell, the first black Head teacher in Wales. Ms. Aksouh also provided teachers with a range of activities including some Caribbean recipes and poetry. If there are any parents who would like to contribute something before the end of Black History month, please let me know.

We held another successful book fair this week and I would like to thank our English lead, Mrs. Laamri for her efforts. Many books were sold and the proceeds will be used to provide more books in the classrooms and the library for the children. As the books come to us unvetted, we have asked for parents to decide whether they are suitable for their children.

I am extremely grateful to all parents and children that have helped us to improve the area outside Years 1 and 2. It is heartening to see this being used by teachers and children. If your child helped, please let the Office know as we have a special reward lined up for them.

I would like to remind parents that I will be holding a coffee morning on Thursday 13th November on the topic of School Improvement. I am very open to your thoughts and suggestions and I would be very happy to see you there Insha'Allah. 
