## Message from the Headteacher

Asalaam Alaikum parents and carers,

These few weeks have been busy, yet very exciting!

The Spring Book Fair was a successful event, showcasing many genres of writing and new authors. We are grateful to both parents and children who helped the school raise £1720.60 to spend towards more books.

The children in EYFS enjoyed an assembly and workshop about 'birds of prey' where they had the opportunity to see many magnificent species of birds such as: owls, eagles, falcons and kites in action in a controlled environment. In addition to this, the EYFS children have been working hard at developing their phonetical skills to read independently.

Year 1 have enjoyed reading their key text: The True Story of the Three Little Pigs and it has been a pleasure reading their newspaper reports. Earlier this week, Year 1 also had an excellent trip to Hertfordshire Zoo, and it was lovely to hear about their experiences of a fun-filled day of learning.

All the children in Year 2, have been reading the book: Mr Wolf's Pancakes and have been learning more about descriptive writing and the features. The Year 2s have also been learning about the Great Fire of London and have used their researching and DT skills to produced some fantastic models depicting the scene from 1666.

Year 3 enjoyed a movie afternoon watching Charlotte's Web after reading the book. It has been great to see the children develop and improve their comprehension skills this term. The children have also enjoyed learning about different types of rocks, and have been using key scientific enquiry skills during their science lessons.

Year 4 read the book, The Accidental Prime Minister this half term, and enjoyed learning about effective debate and report writing. The Year 4 children have also learnt more about adding and subtracting fractions, and used these skills when making pizzas this term. The Year 4s also continue to practise their times tables enthusiastically!

The parent occupation talks were much appreciated by our children and we will endeavour to keep this collaboration active. It was a pleasure meeting many parents and carers at both, the PINS Coffee Morning and Headteacher's Forum this term.

Wishing you all a blessed half term break, and I look forward to seeing our children back on Monday 24th February.

4. Visit our exhibition on Monday 24th March 2025 to be inspired by the Quran!



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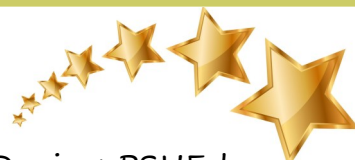
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## 'Pupils of the Week' Achievements

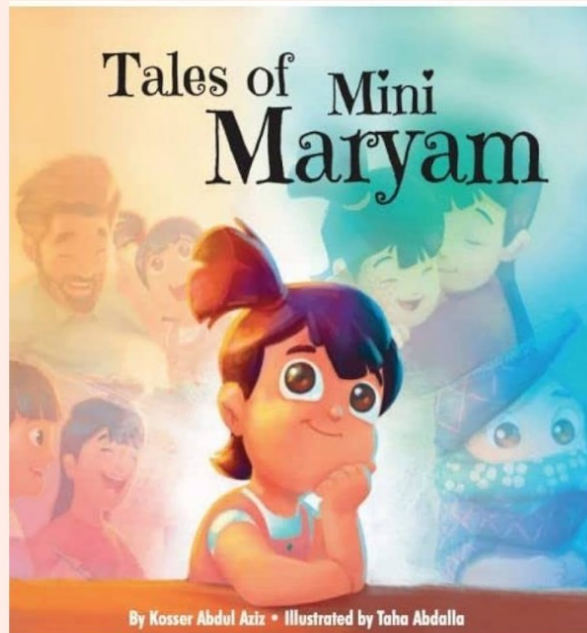

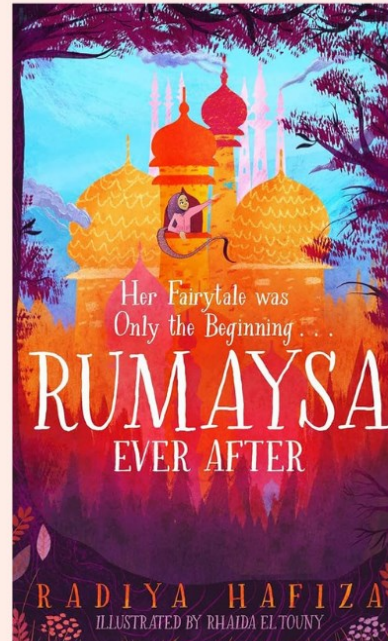
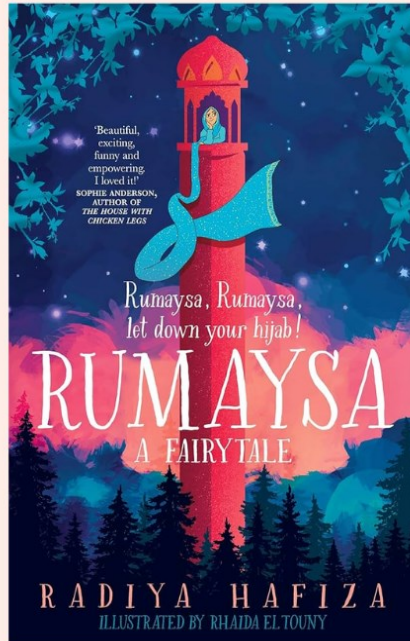
