Message from the Headteacher

Asalaam Alaikum parents and carers,

Firstly, I would like to send a really big thanks to all of our parents for your warm wishes and gifts at the end of Ramadhan. You are a wonderful community and may Allah (SWT) grant you all success in this world and in the hereafter. I do hope that all our families are enjoying the very good weather we have been experiencing. Please remember to supply your child with a hat and sun cream. It is important that they have a water bottle at school at all times and particularly

I am pleased to say that we have made some improvements in the number of days our children attend school but we are still below the national average and we have not yet reached our target. Please try to ensure that trips are taken during the thirteen weeks afforded to us each year rather than during term time so that we can really celebrate this as a success at the end of the school year.

Summer term is usually the busiest term of all for school staff and this term will be no exception. In June, our Year 4 children will complete their multiplication tables test and our Year 1 children will have their phonics screening check. I am sure that they have been well prepared for these by their teachers and parents.

At the weekend, I had the pleasure of meeting with old boys and girls who attended our school site in the 1950's and 60's as pupils of Harrow Weald Grammar School. The well known children's author, Michael Rosen, used to attend the school and he signed one of his books for our children. They have promised to remain in touch and we will arrange an assembly on the history of the school site shortly. They were delighted that the site is still used for the education of children. Our bikeability sessions were very well attended by children in Year 4 this week and I am pleased that so many of them successfully completed their training.

There has been a very good uptake of children attending the new LAMDA public speaking club and I am sure that this will help to build confidence amongst our older children. As many of you will know, we have launched our Hujjat Walking Club and the first walk will take place this coming Sunday at 10:00am. The School Office sent out an email to all parents in which full details are supplied, including a map showing our meeting point. Although it was intended for children in Years 3 and 4, I have received requests from parents of younger children to join in and nobody will be turned away. Please note that all children must be accompanied by an adult through the entirety of the walk. The walks will be arranged fortnightly and an email with a map will be sent out Insha'Allah.

Thankyou to all of our teachers who are providing parents with curriculum guidance and also to the parents who are attending the sessions. I will be running a Head teacher's forum on 15th May and the topic will be SEND provision at Hujjat Primary School. I look forward to seeing as many parents as possible. In the meantime, have a lovely weekend.


