Message from the Headteacher

Asalaam Alaikum parents and carers,

I pray that you and your lovely families are all well.

Yesterday morning, children were greeted by a penguin at the school gates. This was not a result of the slightly cooler weather, our PE partners PSD were handing out leaflets for their fun week Active Camp which will take place at Hujjat during half term. Last week Year 3 visited the Natural History Museum. The children had a very enjoyable day and I was particularly pleased that they had the opportunity to travel by public transport which was a new experience for some. We did return rather late and I would like to thank all of our Year 3 parents who showed a great deal of patience with the delay. I had the pleasure of attending Al Wahhaab's assembly this week and I was hugely impressed, particularly by the children's recitation. Thank you to Ms. Laamri for putting together such a lovely event.

Thank you to all the parents who attended my third Head Teacher's Forum of the year. The focus was special needs and the school's graduated approach. Parents' comments were very supportive and they were pleased to see the processes and mindset regarding our approach to SEND and it is one of which can all be proud.

As many of you will know, we are required to carry out an annual lockdown practice as a safeguarding requirement. A lockdown would take place in cases of emergency when there is a possibility that those in school could be put in danger because of the actions of an individual or group or an event such as a gas leak or a similar local issue. During half term, further work will take place to strengthen the security at the front of the school and this will be visible very soon Insha'Allah.

Please remember that we have plans to improve the playground experience for children in Key Stage 1 and we intend to renovate the area directly outside the Key Stage 1 classes. Our plans are ambitious and involve the creation of areas for nature, eating, drama, growing and reading. We have asked for families to help us coming to school from 9:30am on Saturday 14th June, Saturday 21st June and Saturday 5th July Insha'Allah. Please bring your own gardening tools. If you can help for the day or a part of it, you will be doing an amazing service for the community. We are asking you to donate the following; old bags and suitcases, old crates and containers, old tyres and traffic cones, pots and pans and old kitchen utensils, outdoor picnic tables, large and small paintbrushes and old childrens' clothes. We want to provide much more for the children to play with and to improve their experience.

Finally, I am going to ask for class reps from each class in the very near future to liaise directly with me. If you are interested, please complete the application which will be with you shortly.
