Season	Seasons are periods of similar weather. We have 4 seasons.
Autumn	Autumn takes place in: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> September October November
Winter	Winter takes place in: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> December January February
Spring	Spring takes place in: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> March April May
Summer	Summer takes place in: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> June July August
Weather	This is how sunny, rainy, windy, snowy etc that it is. It changes with the seasons.
sunrise	The time in the morning when the sun first appears in the sky.
sunset	The time in the evening when the sun disappears out of sight in the sky.
