Message from the Headteacher

Asalaam Alaikum parents and carers,

It is lovely to be back at school despite the recent rainy weather which we should always remember is always a gift and blessing from Allah (SWT).

Many of you will have noticed that we have had barriers up in the Key Stage 2 playground. This has simply been because it has been too muddy for the children to play there. Even though there is a lot of mud, I am concerned that this is preventing the children from enjoying the full playground area and the barriers will be removed. I am sure that children can play safely in this area although I can't guarantee that clothes will be completely spotless!

We are delighted that a number of our teachers are taking time away to start families and enjoy parenthood. With that has come the need to recruit cover teachers. I am delighted with the start, that Ms Rashid has made in Al Khaaliq (2K) and I am pleased to advise that Ms Shariff (2W) and Ms Abdi (5G) will be with us in Al Wahhaab (2W) and Al Ghafoor (5G).

They will be preparing an assembly on this during the coming weeks. Alongside this, we are running an Active Travel poster competition to encourage healthy forms of transport and cleaner air. 
