#### Message from the Headteacher

Asalaam Alaikum parents and carers,

I pray that you and your lovely children are well.

At the beginning of last week I began liaising with 'Travel for Life' with a view to gaining a TFL stars award for the school. This will involve some exciting projects for the children, including learning how to travel safely by bicycle in our school playground. For children in Year 4. Please look out for the email. Ms Laamri received a fantastic response to her Muslim superhero poster competition both in terms of numbers and quality. In fact, she decided to find even more winners and two teachers contributed to the prizes.

We have started our boosters this week and the roll out has been very smooth. I am pleased that so many children have been attending. 
