Message from the Headteacher

Asalaam Alaikum parents and carers,

It seems hard to believe that we are almost half way through the academic year but Spring half term is coming fast upon us. We have now started our programme of class assemblies which began with a wonderful performance of Macbeth by Al Adl class. The performance highlighted Islamic morals and values throughout, together with some lovely nasheeds. Thank you to the children and to Mrs. Bmini for preparing the performance. We are expecting to start a drama club in Summer term with a full performance of the play (at Key Stage 2 level). Whilst writing this, I am very much looking forward to Reception's performance this Friday.

Mrs. Saad, myself and Mrs. Sookun (as cover English lead) have been into all classes this week to review the quality of the teaching and learning that is taking place. During these observations we also review books and speak with children to ascertain the extent of their learning. We saw some very good teaching and highly encouraging responses from the children and (as is always the case) we offered further advice and assistance to make the teaching even better.

The event was very well attended, highly informative and some very productive discussions took place.
