This half-term, we are going to express our ideas and experiences through sculpture. We will be creating a paper mache sculpture of the physical and human features we are learning about in geography. The children will be learning about pitch, through the nasheed 'Your Mother' by Yusuf Islam, with opportunities for listening and reflecting, composition and performance. Reflecting on the lyrics of the nasheed, children will make links with the school values and the verse 4:36 from the Holy Quran. They will also be learning about the short vowels in the Arabic language and developing their vocabulary as they learn new words with each letter of the alphabet.
