
Additional Information:

Parking on-site and around the school

A reminder for all parents/carers, Please do not pull your car up to the parking

barrier, if you have not been granted permission to park on-site. We have had many near miss incidents where Parents / Carers are trying to reverse back onto oncoming traffic and causing hazard to pedestrians and vehicles. This is to ensure safety for other vehicles and for our children when walking to and from the school premises.

Additionally, please ensure you park with more consideration anywhere in the school vicinity, particularly Brookshill, Fontwell and Uxbridge Road during drop off and collection times; this in turn ensures more safety for our children.
