I hope you have had a lovely week.

Thank you to all our parents who attended Parent Teacher Meetings this week: the teachers were all very pleased to share children's attainment and progress this term. If you were unable to attend the meeting, please liaise with your child's class teacher at the end of the day or the school office to reschedule another mutually convenient time.

In this week's assembly, we focused on the month of Ramadan: it's significance and how we all have a part towards making it special by demonstrating our school values. Please reiterate this message with children during the weekend in readiness for Ramadan next week!

All the teachers have been carrying out formative assessments across the school. EYFS teachers are target setting for children in preparation for the summer term, with a particular focus on numeracy and early writing. In Year 1, the team are continuing to practice their knowledge of number and place values, as well as their phase-words for the upcoming phonics check in June. The staff in Year 2 will focus on induvial groups of children's needs (with a focus on mathematics, reading and writing) and Year 2 booster classes will start next week. These will be carried out during the school day and teachers will keep in touch about children's progress.
