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### Message from the Acting Headteacher

*Asalaam Alaikum*  
*Peace be upon you.*

We have had an exciting week at school: the Year 2 children have confidently completed their end of year Key Stage 1 tests; the Year 1 children continued to develop their phonetical awareness; and the children in Reception classes have been learning about life cycles through chicks which have hatched in the class incubator this week!

This week staff and pupils had the opportunity to participate in mindfulness sessions which focused on the importance of keeping healthy: both physically and mentally. We also had a whole school assembly on Mental Health and Wellbeing during which we all discussed how vital it is for us to look after ourselves and remember to speak to someone we trust, if we feel worried, unhappy or unsafe about anything. We shared the verse: *أَلَا بِذِكْرِ اللَّهِ تَطْمَئِنُّ الْقُلُوبُ* "...no doubt in the remembrance of Allah hearts find rest." (13.28) and ended our assembly with a beautiful prayer, "O Allah, help us to look after myself everyday by praying and reflecting. And by seeking the help of others around us who care for us. Please take some time this weekend discussing the importance of keeping good mental health and wellbeing.

Attendance this week has been good! Parents and carers are encouraged to maintain this attendance level by ensuring children are coming into school daily and on time. Thank you for your continued support with this.

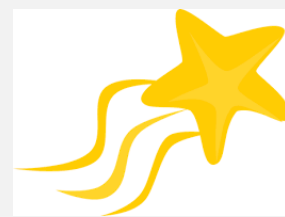
