<u>Limited parking on-site</u>

A few parents and/ or children have been granted permission to park on-site for drop offs and collections. Parents parking on-site are urged to kindly drop and pick up children promptly (without using this time to liaise with other parents); this is to ensure there are enough spaces for others to park, as well as to maintain health and safety.

Parking on-site and around the school

A reminder for all parents/carers, for late drop off and after school clubs there is no parking on site. If your child is attending Clubs Complete-After School Club, only then can you park on site.

Additionally, please ensure you park with more consideration anywhere in the school vicinity, particularly Brookshill, Fontwell and Uxbridge Road during drop off and collection times; this in
