Literacy

This half term we will be focusing on writing letters, in addition to writing and performing poetry.

We will be using a feature rich text (Dear Dinosaur) to explore letters as well as looking at the author's use of the personal pronoun 'I', use of question marks, adjectives, nouns, verbs, and the prefix 'un'. We will also be continuing to develop our handwriting, sentence composition and use of capital letters and correct punctuation.

We will then move on to looking at poetry, some which can be recited, others which can be performed. The children will have the opportunity to write and perform their own poems.

Maths

Place value within 50 – Children will look at how to count more efficiently by learning to count in 2s and 5s up to the number 50.

Measurement – length and height – The children will be looking at comparing length and height using mathematical vocabulary as well as learning how to measure length and height using non-standard units of measure. Then the children will be introduced to how to use a ruler to measure in standardised units of measure. This will also provide an opportunity to consolidate addition and subtraction skills.

Measurement – weight and volume – Year 1 will be using mathematical vocabulary to compare the weight and mass of objects, before moving onto to compare objects by weighing them using non-standard units of measure. Similarly, the children will compare and measure the volume and capacity of different containers.

Art & Design

This half term in art and design, we will be exploring and using simple mechanisms to enhance a functional product – a moving story book. Children will communicate ideas in a variety of ways against the backdrop of set design criteria.

Science

In science we will be investigating the changes in daylight and weather in the season of spring.

PSHE

This half term in PSHE, the children will continue to think about how they can be themselves by expressing their views and feelings with confidence. They will then move onto thinking about how they can function as part of a team by making good choices, being kind and listening to others.
