Hujjat Primary School

Literacy

We will be reading a variety of texts which have cross curricular links to other subjects being studied this term (winter and animals). Using high-quality literature, children will discuss their understanding of the text, identify and use; punctuation marks (full stop, exclamation and question marks), plural nouns (using the suffixes -s and -es) and the conjunction 'and'. We will have the opportunity to apply our new spellings, punctuation and grammar when writing information texts, diary entries and a newspaper report.

Science

In Science, we will be learning about animals. We will be developing our existing knowledge of the different animal groups by exploring the structure (vertebrates and non-vertebrates) and diet (carnivores, herbivores and omnivores) of common animals.

We will also be investigating the changes in daylight and weather in the current season – winter.

Computing

Year 1 will be using Chromebooks for the first time, learning how to log in to their Google Classroom independently. They will be exploring how to create, store and retrieve digital content. Computing will be used to write digitally and explore the ways in which layout and design can affect written work.

Year 1 Curriculum Map Spring – Term 1 Theme:

Animal Magic

Maths

Addition and subtraction within 20 – children will learn to add by counting on from 10 and using their existing knowledge of number bonds to 10 to efficiently find number bonds to 20. Building upon this, children will use their number bonds to add by making 10. We will then move onto subtraction not crossing 10 and then crossing 10 (partitioning)

Place value within 50 – children will explore and learn numbers to 50, looking at how many tens and ones make a given number, using this knowledge they will be able to find one more and less as well as compare numbers within 50. Children will also look at starting to count in multiples of 2 and 5.

Art & Design

This half term in art and design, we will be using the mediums of clay and papier mache to sculpt. We will be examining the form of common animals and replicating their likeness through careful observation. Looking at the work of other sculptors the children will explore using this art form to share their own unique ideas.

PSHE

This half term in PSHE, the children will be thinking about themselves learning from their own experiences in order to celebrate their own success and set challenging goals. They will be learning the vocabulary to express their feelings and recognise what they like and dislike (making informed choices).

R.E

In religious education, Year 1 will be learning about days of religious importance. They will be exploring unity and collective worship when looking at Jumu'ah, the significance of Eid /Shahru Ramadan and how these compare to Shabbat in the Jewish faith. This half-terms values will be service and gratitude.
