Curriculum Newsletter YEAR 2 | Autumn Term

Welcome to Year 2! We have a fun and enriching half-term ahead as we start our journey into Year 2. Teaching this year in Year 2 are Mrs Laamri and Miss Shah, supported by Mrs Naveed, Mrs Rahemtulla and Mrs Gulamali. Here is a breakdown of the skills and knowledge to be covered in each subject through this half-term:

English

In Literacy, the children will learn how to write setting descriptions using their 5 senses to build detail into their writing. Next, they will explore comparative writing and will compare characters. For non-fiction, the children will learn how to write a letter using the correct structure. Lastly, children will learn how to retell a story including expanded noun phrases, adverbs, verbs and conjunctions.

Mathematics

In Maths, the children will consolidate their place value learning and explore the base 10 system even further.

The children will also develop their learning of addition and subtraction. The children will be learning through a combination of:

Concrete: using objects such as cubes

Pictorial: drawings to show amounts
