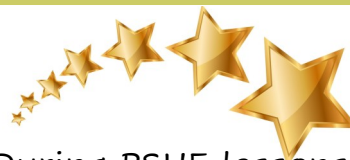

# The Amin Ambassadors and Ardh Ambassadors

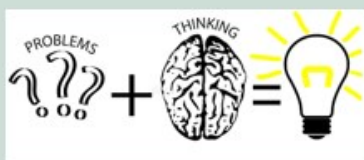

# **Birthdays and Celebrations at Hujjat Primary School**

We love to celebrate the milestones of our children and help them build happy memories at school. We are proud to have a diversity of cultural and religious backgrounds within our school community. We respect the differences in practices between different denominations of faith and different cultures and therefore, do not collectively sing 'Happy Birthday' to the children as a whole class or school. However, if a child mentions it is their birthday, school staff will ensure the child feels heard and valued to make their day that bit more special. We embrace the way that the child chooses to celebrate with their friends over the course of the day to help them create those special memories at school.

To ensure the safety and well-being of our students, we are unable to allow the exchange of treats or gifts on birthdays and other special occasions. This decision is made with the understanding that some children may have allergies, as well as wanting to avoid putting any pressure on other parents to provide treats. As an alternative, **we encourage parents to donate a book to the school with a special message to mark the occasion.** This will be a lasting gift from you and your child to the school for years to come. The message will be placed inside the book and given to the class so that the child can share it with their class.
