Message from the Headteacher

Asalaam Alaikum parents and carers,

I hope that you and your children have all had a wonderful Winter break and a great start to the new year.

As Reception parents know, we have been providing catch up sessions for children needing extra help to achieve in their phonics. This term we will be starting booster classes for targeted children in each year group in Key Stage 1 and Key Stage 2. I would like to thank in advance the members of staff who have agreed to give up their time to help the children with this project. Each Year, we will review the chosen groups so that more children are able to benefit from this support over time. Many parents have asked about drama and music at Hujjat Primary School. There are plans for a choir and we will be starting a new drama club at the beginning of summer term Insha'Allah.

A group of Year 4 children represented us at a debate competition held at Hatch End High School where they competed with children from other Harrow primary schools. They debated the following topics; Should the school day start later in the day? Can money buy happiness? Is homework essential in the learning process? Do schools need to have more male teachers? Although they did not win, they did a fantastic job, particularly as they were competing with Year 5 children. Staff from the other schools commented on their excellent behaviour and attitudes. Speaking of such attitudes, a group of our children showed our school values of compassion, respect, service and excellence when they visited the elderly residents of a local care home and again the comments were very favourable. It is important that we maintain these positive relationships with our neighbours to offset some of the negativity that is caused as a result of parking issues.

I would like to thank the parents who have now begun the slightly daunting task of speaking to our children regarding their occupations. We had the first of these on Thursday and feedback from staff and children has been outstanding. I am sure that these talks will help to provide context for the national curriculum.



'Pupils of the Week' Achievements


