Message from the Headteacher

Asalaam Alaikum parents and carers,

Ramadhan Mubarak to you all and I pray that all is well with you and your families during this very special time. It feels like no time since the term restarted and I usually find that time passes very quickly between now and summer term. I think that this will be even more the case with Ramadhan falling squarely within term time, as the month is often over far too quickly.

Book week has been particularly enjoyable this week and I would like to thank Mrs Laamri for her amazing efforts in making it one to remember. I thought it was a brilliant idea to link traditional stories and tales with an Islamic element and both children and staff thoroughly enjoyed the day. We had the author Kosser Abdul Aziz who read her book to the children and lead an arts and crafts session with children in Reception and Key Stage 1. We were slightly disappointed that another author, Radiyah Hafiza was unable to attend this week but we are assured that she will be able to visit us next Friday, Insha'Allah. The children presented the work they had done over book week at today's assembly and I was very impressed with both the range and quality of the work produced by the children. Year 4 will be taking the national times tables test (2's to 12's) in June. Mrs Sookun is busy preparing some assessments so that we can prepare the children properly for these. Mrs Al-Sader has been busy preparing our children along with their class teachers in Year 1 for the phonics screening check that will also take place in June. Girls in Year 4 did themselves and their school proud with their efforts, behaviour and attitudes when they went swimming at Hatch End school last week. The pool has kindly suspended lessons during Ramadhan and will make up for this by providing slightly longer lessons when they return.

Parents in some classes will have received a letter from Mrs Jessa and I regarding the use of the internet and social media by our children. We live in an age, in which the very positive benefits of communication technology are sometimes tarnished by the amount of time that children spend in front of screens and the content of what is viewed. We know that the vast majority of our parents are very strict and vigilant with regard to this. I have asked staff to be especially vigilant in this so that the school is able to act immediately to support families if there are any concerns.

Quranic Project & Exhibition

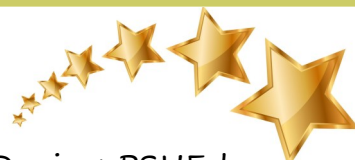
This Ramadhan Hujjat Primary School are hosting a Quran Exhibition and we would love for your creative artwork to be a part of it. Here is how to take part:
