### Message from the Headteacher

#### Salaamu Alaikum wa Rahmatullahi wa Barakhatahu

I would like to start by welcoming all of our new Reception parents and children to the school now that every child in the Early Years is at school, at the beginning of what I pray will be a wonderful learning journey for them at Hujjat. I have been busy working with our subject leaders this week, working on our curriculum to ensure that it is still the right curriculum for our children in terms of the school demographic and our school vision. Our focus will be to ensure that our Islamic ethos pervades the children's learning experience and that it really does encourage curiosity and critical thinking. The teachers themselves are getting to know your children and we have held meetings this week to look at their work so far and to ensure that everything is on track for a successful year Insha'Allah. I am delighted that some of our teachers are forming their own voluntary focussed groups within key stages for after school meetings (without direction from senior staff). This is a sign of a school developing in maturity and a strong desire to do the best that we possibly can for our children.

It was wonderful to see so much interest in our school when we invited prospective parents to visit last week and we had an excellent parental turnout at the curriculum morning for parents of children in years 1 and 2. The discussions were very supportive and we had lots of very pertinent questions at the meeting, including some relating to the behaviour policy and reward systems. These discussions are very useful to me in terms of gauging the parental view.

Earlier this week we had the FOHPS Potluck Picnic. Unfortunately, I was unable to make an appearance despite being on the premises but the feedback has been excellent and thank you to FOHPS for all their hard work and to all parents who attended and donated to the school.

Some of you may have seen two visitors on the school playground on Wednesday afternoon. They were here to look at our school as a model for how to set up their own faith school in Birmingham, which is highly encouraging. There will be an opportunity arising soon for some of our girls to take part in a local competitive football event so please look out for an email if your daughter has been chosen by coaching staff to take part. A similar event should also be available shortly for our Badminton Club players to take part in a similar competition.

I have sent out a request for volunteers to help, particularly on our playgrounds and I am very grateful to those who have expressed an interest.

Finally, another reminder that we are holding an autumn gardening day on Sunday 5th October, subject to the weather conditions. We will also run our first Hujjat Walking Club event of the Autumn Term the following week. Please refer to my emails for more information.

## The Amin Ambassadors and Ardh Ambassadors




## 'Pupils of the Week' Achievements
