Message from the Headteacher

Asalaam Alaikum parents and carers,

This first half of term has passed by with such speed. It has been a busy and a very enjoyable start to the year for the children. Reception class completed their baseline assessments and I would like to thank Ms Al Sader and Ms Aksouh for their hard work in this regard. Parents should begin to see a few changes to the outdoor Reception area as we begin to develop it. Children in other classes have been completing their unit tests and it has been a pleasure to watch the children learning over this period and I have felt very encouraged by my visits to the classrooms during this part of term.

Year 2 are visiting the Chiltern Open Air Museum today to enhance and enrich their learning around the stone age and the bronze age. I am sure that this will be a rewarding experience. Other year groups will attend similar trips this term. I would like to see our school engaging more with national competitions and local opportunities. Ms. Somji is very kindly making arrangements for our children to enter The Bebras Challenge which is delivered in partnership with Oxford University and introduces computational thinking to students worldwide. The challenge will take place in school but we need your consent so please return this as soon as possible. We are looking into the possibility of inter-school sports competitions and in January our older children will take part in an inter-school debate competition. I have also asked teachers to use google classroom to provide you with details of the BBC 500 words competition which is open to children from 5-11 and encourages them to simply write a story they would love to read in under 500 words. The competition runs independently of the school and might be a lovely half-term activity.

A huge thanks to the parents who cleared the area, including driveways from rubbish that had been left by users of Brookshill. I am sure that our neighbours were very grateful for this wonderful gesture. Finally, a quick reminder that the Khayyal Theatre will be at school on the 8th November Inshallah.
