Message from the Headteacher

Asalaam Alaikum Parents and Carers,

As we will not be seeing you on Friday, please let me start by wishing you all a joyous and successful Ramadhan.

Please read through Mrs. Jessa's email which sets out in detail all of the information that you will need regarding any changes to our usual procedures and school starting times during the final ten days of the holy month. Reminders will be sent out shortly.

This has been a very short term but we have managed to pack quite a lot into it. I am delighted that our teachers stepped up to improve our extra curricular offer by providing a wide range of clubs in January. We have also been able to provide more in terms of wellbeing with the LEGO therapy provision and Emotional Literacy Support Assistant training (ELSA), together with sessions for children who have unfortunately suffered bereavement.

The Senior Leadership Team has been into all of our classes and we are pleased with what we have seen of work tailored for the children according to need, whether higher or lower attainers, and some quality teaching. There is always a need for improvement no matter where we are and we continue to strive for excellence in every class and every lesson. Two of our teachers attended a writing moderation session at Weald Rise Primary School this week along with teachers representing other schools in our cluster. The purpose of these sessions is to ensure that our judgements and those of other schools, on the question of whether a child is reaching age related expectation or otherwise is an accurate one. A further moderation will take place for Year 1 and Year 2 writing very shortly.

A big thanks to Mrs. Saad and Mrs. Sookun for running our book fair this week. They were extremely busy throughout and it was a pleasure seeing so many children showing interest in the books that were on offer.

I was pleased to hear that the Year 5 and Year 1 educational visits went very well. Teachers reported that the Year 1 trip to Hertfordshire Zoo was a great success and that the Year 5s had an excellent experience at the RAF museum in Hendon. A big thanks to all the parent volunteers who attended and to the children whose behaviour and attitudes throughout both trips was outstanding.

I have rescheduled my Head Teacher's forum meeting for 9:15am on Wednesday 4th March on the subject of Anxiety in Primary Aged Children, its Causes and Solutions. We will be in Ramadhan by then but I really think that this will be an important meeting. Childhood anxiety is something that is becoming increasingly an issue for children of all backgrounds and faiths.

Well done to Al Haqq and Al Ghafoor class for their lovely assemblies over the past two weeks and also to their teachers who worked hard to coordinate them. Finally, a really big shout out to our Al Haqq Reception class for having the best attendance in the school this week!

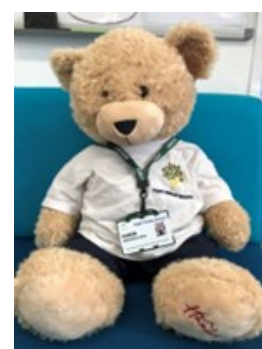
'Pupils of the Week' Achievements

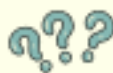
