Ruggedly beautiful Bosnia and Herzegovina is most intriguing for its East-meets-West atmosphere born of blended Ottoman and Austro-Hungarian histories filtered through a Southern Slavic lens. Visitors are likely to remember the country for its deep, unassuming human warmth, its beautiful mountains, numerous medieval castle ruins, pristine and clear rivers, impressive waterfalls, bargain-value skiing, and unbelievable Herzegovina wine country whose history of wine making spans back to ancient times.

On this trip, we would also like to give you a taste of Croatia - a popular tourist destination known for its long coastline with crystal-clear waters and over a thousand islands, historic cities, and stunning national parks. Croatia has a rich history and culture, with many ancient cities and historic landmarks, of which we will visit the UNESCO World Heritage Sites of Dubrovnik and Split.



Accommodations and transport while in the country:

3 nights at Courtyard by Marriott hotel in Sarajevo

3 nights at Emporia hotel or another compatible 4 star hotel in Mostar.

1 night at Atrium hotel in Split

1 night at Lacroma hotel in Dubrovnik

2 nights at Park hotel in Trebinje

DESCRIPTION OF 11-DAY ITINERARY:

DAY 1 –

- Program will be determined after time of arrival is known.
- Dinner at Pivnica - Sarajevska brewery. Everyone responsible for their own dinner and drinks.



DAY 2 –

- 7 a.m. – 9 a.m. Breakfast at hotel Courtyard by Marriott - included in the price
- 10 a.m. City tour with local guide - included in the price
- Lunch at Bascarsija - Cevapi, traditional Bosnian beef and lamb sausages served in a hot pita bread. Included in the price.

- 13:00 p.m. Trip with a cable car to Olympic mountain Trebevic for a great view of the city from above. Possibility of a walk in the woods and seeing the remains of the Olympic bob sleigh track. - included in the price
- 3:30 p.m. Return to the city with cable car and free time for own activities. Ex YU ROCK Center Museum recommended to visit (<https://ex-yurock.com/>). - cable car ticket included in the price
- Sevdalinka, traditional Bosnian music short concert at Svrzo House Museum.
Svrzo House Museum: An oasis of whitewashed walls, cobbled courtyards and partly vine-draped dark timbers, this 18th-century house-museum has been brilliantly restored and appropriately furnished, helping visitors to imagine Sarajevo life in Ottoman times. - concert ticket included in the price



DAY 3 –

- 7a.m. – 9.30 a.m. Breakfast at hotel Courtyard by Marriott (included in price)
- 10.30 a.m. Check out from the hotel, depart for Mostar
- 12 a.m. Stop in Jablanica town, visit Museum of the Battle of Neretva from WW II - included in the price
- 1.30 p.m. depart Jablanica
- 1.45 p.m. Lunch at a restaurant on the lake in Jablanica, the best know area for roasted lamb. (lunch and one drink included in price).
- 3 p.m. Depart to Mostar and check into hotel
- 4.p.m. Guided city tour of Mostar old town (UNESCO World heritage site) with a visit to the famous Old bridge. (included in price)
- 5.30 p.m. – 7 p.m. free time in Mostar
- 7 p.m. transfer to Carski Vinogradi (Royal vineyards) dinner and wine tasting (included in price).
- Overnight in Mostar.



DAY 4 –

- 7a.m. – 9.30 a.m. Breakfast at hotel in Mostar (included in price)
- 10 a.m. Transfer to town of Čitluk.
- 11 a.m. Wine Tasting at Grgo Vasilj winery (included in price)
- 1.30 p.m. Winery Andrija for lunch and wine tasting (included in price)
- 4 p.m. return to Mostar area for free time. Stop at Kameni Vinogradi (Stone Vineyards where Stone Cuvee, our most popular white wine, grapes are grown). Welcome spirits drink at the vineyard. (included in price)
- 7 p.m. dinner and wine tasting at Romanca restaurant located in the middle off Čitluk winery vineyards. (included in price)
- After dinner return to hotel. Overnight.



DAY 5 –

- 7a.m. – 9.30 a.m. Breakfast at hotel in Mostar and check-out. - included in the price

- 10 a.m. travel to Počitelj, an open air museum and medieval town and fortress which has been preserved and turned into an artist colony.
- 12 p.m. continue towards Kravica waterfall and visit this magnificent oasis in the middle of a very dry region - tickets to the park included in the price.
- 1.30 p.m. Wine tasting at Nuić winery near the town of Ljubuški (included in price)
- Lunch at Koćuša waterfall located near the winery Nuić. (included in price) . Everyone responsible for their drinks.
- 4 p.m. Transfer to Split, Croatia.
- 6.30 p.m. check into hotel and overnight. Dinner and a drink in a restaurant in the Old town included in the price.



DAY 6 –

- 7a.m. – 9.00 a.m. Breakfast at hotel Atrium (included in price)
- 9.30 a.m. Split city tour with a local guide (included in price)
- 11.30 a.m. transfer to Dubrovnik with a trip across Peljesac bridge and stop in town of Ston famous for its oyster farms. The oysters from the Bay of Ston near Dubrovnik are considered of the highest quality in Europe. These oyster farms supply the markets and restaurants of Italy and France.
- Oyster harvesting experience with the local oyster and mussel producer and a traditional Dalmatian light lunch/dinner (lunch and one glass of Croatian wine Posip or Plavac Mali Included In the price)
- 3 p.m. after lunch continuing towards Dubrovnik with a stop in Trsteno and quick visit of local botanical garden which was featured in Game of Thrones series.
- 7:00 p.m. arrival to Dubrovnik and check into hotel. Dinner at the hotel or in the city. Everyone responsible for their own food at the hotel or downtown Old Dubrovnik, a short taxi ride from the hotel. Overnight.



DAY 7 – Dubrovnik all day

- 7a.m. – 9.30 a.m. Breakfast at hotel Lacroma President. (included in price)
- 10 a.m. guided city tour of Old town Dubrovnik and its city walls (UNESCO World heritage site) afterwards free time for own activities. (included in price)
- Visit of Dubulj family olive oil plantation in village of Orasac near Dubrovnik where traditional dalmatian lunch will be organized as well as traditional olive oil methods explained and demonstrated. (lunch, a glass of wine and olive oil tasting included in price)
- Transfer towards Trebinje for dinner and wine and overnight. (dinner included in the price)



DAY 8 – Trebinje all day

- 7a.m. – 9.30 a.m. Breakfast at Hotel - included in the price
- Lunch and one drink at one of the local restaurants near the river (included in price). Everyone responsible for additional drinks.
- 2:00 p.m. wine tasting with Anđelić winery.- included in the price)
- 7 p.m. Dinner and wine tasting at the winery Podrumi Vukoje (dinner and wine tasting included in price).
- Overnight in Trebinje.



DAY 9 – Trebinje - Stolac - Buna - Mostar

- 7 a.m. – 9 a.m. Breakfast at Hotel Park, Trebinje - included in the price.
- 9 a.m. visit of typical Balkan green market at the town square located next to the hotel.
- 11.30 a.m. Continuing towards town of Stolac, UNESCO protected world heritage site and visit to Radimlja Necropolis, an open air museum that houses about 110 stećci (carved grave-markers) from medieval times. (Museum entrance fee and guide included in the price)
- 12.30 p.m. Transfer to Blagaj. Visit Tekija and spring of River Buna, largest single source of any river in Europe with an output of 50m³ per second in certain periods of year.
- 2.30 p.m. Lunch in restaurant next to the river (Lunch and one glass of wine or another drink included in price).
- 4 p.m. transfer to Hotel in Mostar. Free time
- 6 p.m. There is a nice wine and gift shop in the center of the town. Bosnian cheese and wine tasting and gift shopping. (cheese and wine tasting included in the price)
- Mostar. Overnight. Dinner and wine tasting at Restaurant Behar or Hidin Han in Old Town.



DAY 10 –

- 7a.m. – 9.30 a.m. Breakfast at hotel in Mostar.
- 10 a.m. transfer to town of Konjic for two activities to chose from:
 - 1.whitewater rafting on river Neretva, with a barbecue lunch on the banks of the river at half way point. This is one of the signature experiences in all of the Balkans.
 2. Alternative activity for people not interested in rafting will be a tour of town of Konjic, visit to traditional Bosnian furniture maker and a visit to Titov Bunker (museum tickets, lunch, rafting and food included in the price)

- 5 p.m. Continuing to Sarajevo
- 6.30 p.m. Check in. Free time.
- Burek (stuffed filo dough) making experience and tasting in Bascarsija (included in price).



DAY 11 –

- Check out time from the hotel and program will be based on time of departure.
