Tournament Format

One (1) two-day limited tournament with 28 teams (19 Regular, 3 Multibreed, and 6 Open teams from 15 clubs), in 1 ring with 70+ ft of runback. Regional Info

This is a Region 9 tournament. Amanda Brown is the Regional Director. There is cross listing of dogs allowed (i.e. a dog may be listed on multiple teams). This tournament DOES count for multibreed class regional championship purposes. This tournament DOES count for regular class regional championship purposes.

Titles/Awards

Friday and Saturday Night Turf Time

We are offering "turf time" Friday evening, from 5:30pm to 8:30 pm, and Saturday after racing until 8pm if there is interest. Friday Night Turf Time sign up has been posted in Mid-Atlantic. Saturday turf time sign up will be available at the head table starting at 3pm on Saturday. Cost will be \$5/5 minutes per lane. If you need both lanes the cost is \$10/5 minutes. Please be ready for your time slot so that we can keep things moving so that everyone has a chance to use their time to its fullest.

Saturday Night Ice Cream Social!

Please join us Saturday for the most important part of flyball - ice cream and socializing! TSF will be providing small ice cream cups for all attendees, please make sure you have sent in your human count so we can be sure there is enough for everyone. We'll begin serving ice cream at 5:30 and will finish after turf time concludes so that everyone can join the party.

Site

The tournament will be held at [Quicksilver Canine](#) in Julian, NC. The facility is heated/air-conditioned (though it is NC in July, please plan accordingly if you/your dogs run hot), and has room for indoor crating for everyone. We will have space marked for clubs. There are electrical outlets every so often and you are welcome to share them. Please plan to tarp your entire crating area (if you are crating on the turf). We will be setting up on Friday from noon until we are done. You may drop off any boxes, crates, etc., after 3 pm Friday night. Please pick up after your dogs; bags and containers will be provided. Please do not allow dogs to urinate on the building, on agility equipment outdoors, or on anything someone has to pick-up. Potty accidents on the turf carry a penalty of \$10.

We will have the garage doors closed and hvac on during the event. Please do not leave doors open so we can keep as much cool air inside as possible.

Entrances/Parking/RV/Camping

Please unload at front door (red drop), then proceed to RV/Car Parking area (green X). Depending on where you are crating indoors, a side/back door may be much closer to your crating area than through the front. No hookups. No electricity. Generators OK. You can fill up your fresh water tank from the front of the building. Also, there are bathrooms inside (no showers) which are available for your use. If you have any questions or concerns about your RV parking area, BEFORE YOU SETUP, level, pull out your slides, etc.
