- Shelf stable meals are ready to eat and require no cooking
- If reheating is desired, please use a microwave-safe dish, and not the original container

If you are scheduled for transportation services on a day that the Station Break closes, due to unsafe conditions you will not be transported. Please have a back-up plan in case your transportation to your appointment gets cancelled on short notice.
