It is **illegal to bring meat products** from pigs, cows, sheep, goats and other ruminants into the Channel Islands:

- from Germany, Hungary, Slovakia, or
- from an EU country (excluding Germany, Hungary and Slovakia), Iceland, Liechtenstein, Norway, Switzerland, the Faroe Islands or Greenland, unless they:
 - · are for personal consumption
 - · weigh no more than 2kg per person
 - are packaged to EU commercial standards, and
 - bear an identification or health mark (or commercial labelling for animal by-products)

These restrictions do not apply to infant milk, medical food and certain low risk composite products.

Foot and mouth is a highly contagious viral disease which can have a devastating impact on livestock health
