CONSTABLE VACANCIES

Become a Constable or an Assistant Constable and support your community. You'll respond to emergencies and provide a reassuring presence, making life safer and happier for everyone who lives on and visits Sark.

Chief Pleas policy is that fixed-term employment posts must be readvertised on expiry of the relevant contract. Constables and Assistant Constables are fixed-term posts.

Chief Pleas is, therefore, seeking applications for Constable and Assistant Constable posts to start in October 2025. These posts are open to residents of Sark. The posts will be for either 1 or 2 years depending on the term of the contract coming to an end.

Constables and Assistant Constables work a rota pattern: typically 2 weeks on / 2 weeks off. The exact timings will be confirmed on appointment with individual preferences, insofar as possible, considered. The remuneration is between £8,765 and £11,685 per annum, depending on post. Both posts have duties: Constable duties include ensuring appropriate training for Assistant Constables, producing an annual report for Chief Pleas, and liaising with Bailiwick policing as needed.

Training and equipment are provided. In addition to this annual training, occasional special training, such as on statement taking or care for people in custody, is also given.

Please note that these posts are subject to satisfactory Disclosure and Barring Service (DBS) checks and references. Post holders may not have other employment that is considered to be in any way in conflict with the position.

Interviews will be conducted by an independent panel who will forward to the Douzaine the nominated candidates for approval by Chief Pleas.
