UK Ministry of Justice Public Meeting

Two members of the MoJ's Crown Dependency Team will present an overview of the relationship and take questions from the public on this and the work of the MoJ.

What is the MoJ?

The MoJ is the UK Government department responsible for justice matters, including courts, prisons and the wider justice system in England and Wales. The Secretary of State for Justice, in his role as Lord Chancellor, also has responsibility for the relationship with the Crown Dependencies on behalf of the Monarch. The current Secretary of State for Justice is David Lammy, who is also Deputy Prime Minister.
