Seasonal Restrictions for Tractors and Horse-Drawn Vehicles

Valid from 1st April to 30th September from 11am to 5pm daily

The Road Traffic Offences (Motor Vehicles and Bicycles) (Sark) (Amendment) Regulations, 2026

- Tractors are only permitted to travel along the Avenue and the road between the Post Office and St Peter's Church in a westbound direction only for the purpose of accessing:
 - a) the home of the driver,
 - b) premises on those roads for the purpose of making a commercial delivery, or
 - c) the Gallery Stores, for the purpose of purchasing or collecting purchased goods the transport of which necessitates the use of a tractor.
- The above roads are closed to all other motor vehicle traffic, other than an invalid carriage during those times.
- It is also prohibited to park a motor vehicle, other than an invalid carriage, during those times, on:
 - a) The Avenue, or
 - b) the road between the Power Station and the Visitor's Centre

The Road Traffic (Horse-Drawn Vehicles) Regulations, 2026

- Horse-drawn vehicles are allowed to travel in an eastbound direction only on the Avenue.
- Horse-drawn vehicles must not stop on the Avenue for the purpose of procuring, boarding, or disembarking passengers.
- A person must not, without the permission of the Constable –
 - a) park a horse-drawn vehicle, or procure or board passengers for it, on a public road, other than –
 - i) in the La Collinette lay-by, or
 - ii) if there is no space in the La Collinette lay-by, on the roadway opposite the old Natwest Bank,
 - or
 - b) park a horse-drawn vehicle on the roadway across from the old Natwest Bank with the vehicle facing any direction other than north.
