#### TC117.25 Website Advertising

The Committee agreed to continue to charge for website advertising for 2025 but would review for 2026.

#### TC118.25 Senior Visitor Officer Recruitment

The Committee agreed that they would defer the recruitment of a Senior Visitor Officer until after the summer. They discussed recruiting a junior 'meet and greet' person who could cover some hours at the Visitor Centre, meet visitors arriving in Sark at the top of the Harbour Hill and also gather social media content for the summer and possibly longer.

The Committee agreed that Tourism would pay landing tax for any journalists and other visitors who are given free travel to and from Sark by Sark Shipping.
