Electricity Price Reduction To 64 p/kwh For August 2026

The maximum unit price that Sark Electricity Limited ("SEL") can charge for electricity will be reduced from 66 p/kwh to 64 p/kwh for the month of August 2026.

The maximum unit price in the Price Control Order is set at 52 p/kwh but this can be adjusted monthly to account for changes in demand and fuel prices compared to the original forecast.

This small price decrease is mainly because fuel prices in June 2026 were lower than the previous month, although they were still 40% higher than the forecast in the Price Control Order. Consumption in June 2026 was 14% lower than forecast.

SEL is entirely dependent on diesel to generate electricity, and diesel prices have risen significantly since the start of the war in the Middle East. Although we have seen some reduction in fuel prices over May and June 2026, there is no guarantee that this trend will continue.

The demand for electricity in Sark has also been c15% lower than the forecast in the Price Control Order and from the demand in the same period last year.
