Electricity Price To Remain At 66 p/kwh For July 2026

The maximum unit price that Sark Electricity Limited (“SEL”) can charge for electricity will remain at 66 p/kwh for the month of July 2026.

The maximum unit price in the Price Control Order is set at 52 p/kwh but this can be adjusted monthly to account for changes in demand and fuel prices compared to the original forecast. The price remains at 66 p/kwh in July 2026 because fuel prices in May 2026 were 60% higher than forecast and demand was 17% lower than forecast.

SEL is entirely dependent on diesel to generate electricity, and prices have risen significantly since the start of the war in the Middle East. However, diesel prices for the first half of June 2026 were 10% lower than prices in May 2026. If this downward trend is maintained for the second half of June, and demand does not fall further, we could expect to see lower electricity prices again from August 2026.
