

BY-ELECTION OF CONSEILLERS

In accordance with the Reform (Sark) Law, 2008 as amended and with the Reform (Election of Conseillers) (By-Election) (Sark) Ordinance, 2024

A BY-ELECTION OF TWO CONSEILLERS SHALL BE HELD ON WEDNESDAY 15th MAY 2024.

The Polling Station shall be at the NEW ISLAND HALL (TOPLIS ROOM) and voting shall take place from 10am until 6pm that day.

PRESCRIBED FORMS OF NOMINATION OF CANDIDATE to stand as a Conseiller are available from the Sark Greffe Office, the Speaker of Chief Pleas Office, and the Chief Pleas website. Each form shall be completed by two persons and the candidate, all of whose names shall be inscribed on the Electoral Register and shall be delivered by hand of one of the persons named on the form to the Speaker or Deputy Speaker of Chief Pleas (Returning Officer and Deputy Returning Officer respectively), not later than NOON on Friday 3rd May 2024. Forms of Nomination shall not be returned before 10am on Monday 29th April 2024.

In the event of an equality of votes being given to two or more candidates, and the addition of one more vote to his/her poll would have entitled such candidate to be elected, a further election shall be held in accordance with the above stated Law and Ordinances on Wednesday 29th May 2024; in respect of such candidates only and without further nomination, between the persons who have obtained such equality of votes. The Polling Station shall be at the same place and between the same hours as stated above. For the purposes of the term of office of any successful candidate such further election shall be deemed to have been held on the date of the original election.
