

CLASSIFICATIONS

The Bailiwick of Guernsey is operating a Category system, which is different to the UK's regional Tier system. The table below explains what each category means for travellers to the Bailiwick. The whole of the UK is currently in Category 4.

Countries Classification

	Prevalence	Testing	Self-isolation
(Air Bridge) Category 1	Equivalent to the Bailiwick of Guernsey and no community seeding	No test required	None required
Category 2	Less than 30 per 100,000 for 7 consecutive days	Test on arrival (Day 1) and Day 7	Self-isolation until the results of the Day 1 test. If negative, enhanced passive follow-up until Day 7. If Day 7 test is negative, passive follow up.
Category 3	Between 30 to 100 per 100,000 for 7 consecutive days	Test on arrival (Day 1) and Day 7	Self-isolation until the results of the Day 7 test. If negative, enhanced passive follow-up until Day 14.
Category 4	More than 100 per 100,000 for 7 consecutive days	Test on arrival (Day 1) and Day 13	Self-isolation for 14 days with a test on Day 13. If you have declined a Day 13 test you will be required to self-isolate for 21 days.

Community non-pharmaceutical interventions are not envisaged at any level, but may be implemented if community seeding is identified or anticipated
