The following applications can be viewed by the public in the <u>Committee Office</u> starting Thursday 12th November 2020 until Thursday, 10th December 2020.

La Tour – To erect 8 rows of 25 solar panels to run parallel to existing panels (each row approx. 35m x 5m x 1.6-1.8m high)

La Rade – To erect a storage shed in the garden (6.0m x 3.0m x 2.87m high)

La Rade – To erect a woodstore & recycling in the garden (5.0m x 3.66m x ?m high)

La Rade – To erect a greenhouse in the garden (5.12m x 2.91m [3.84m] x 3.14m high)

La Rade – To erect a chicken house [&run] in the garden (2.9m x 1.31m x 1.8m high)

La Rade – To open a pedestrian gate onto the public road

Cider Press – To erect a barn in the grounds of the property (9.14m x 9.14m x 4.11m high)

Petit Cae de Mat – To extend existing dwelling (5.48m x 4.63m x 4.53m high)

Le Grand Beauregard – For a 9-hole golf course on the tenement

Decisions made on the applications posted in the Boxes during October/November

La Tour – To erect 8 rows of 25 solar panels to run parallel to existing panels - DEFERRED (each row approx. 35m x 5m x 1.6-1.8m high)

L'Etoile du Nord – To erect a wooden garden shed (4.5m x 3.5m x 2.7m high) and glasshouse in the garden (4.5m x 2.5m x 2.7m high) - <u>APPROVED</u>

Other decisions made at the November meeting

La Ville Farm – To increase the height of the rear extension by 0.8m - <u>ACCEPTED</u> (this is an alteration for the previously approved 1.2m increase)

Tamarisk – To erect a shed/summerhouse at the rear of the property – CONDITIONALLY APPROVED

La Rade – To erect a fruit cage in the garden (9.75m x 2.43m x ?m high) - APPROVED

Beau Vallon – To demolish the remainder of the 'open market' property - ACCEPTED
