5 **The Seneschal:** The purpose of this short Meeting of Chief Pleas is to elect a Speaker of Chief Pleas. The present Speaker's term of office expires on 27th February of this year.

I am here sitting in this Chair because of the provisions of The Reform (Elections of Speaker and Deputy Speaker) (General Provisions) (Sark) Ordinance, 2016, which says:

The Seneschal shall preside over the Meeting of Chief Pleas for the purpose only of the election of the Speaker.

There are two candidates who put their names forward to be Speaker of Chief Pleas. They are: Mr Arthur Rolfe, who has been proposed by Conseiller Philip Long and seconded by Conseiller Helen Plummer; and Lt. Col. Reginald Guille MBE, who has been proposed by Conseiller William Raymond and seconded by Conseiller Sandra Williams.

Before we commence the voting, the Ordinance makes provision for the proposers and seconders to speak in support of their candidate. Conseiller Long is not present, so I ask at this time whether Conseiller Helen Plummer wishes to speak.

Conseiller Plummer: Yes, I do.

The Seneschal: Carry on, please.

20 **Conseiller Plummer:** Thank you.

I have nominated Arthur Rolfe as Speaker of Chief Pleas. I believe he has proved he has been reliable and is a steady pair of hands now and into the future.

Thank you.

25 **The Seneschal:** Thank you.

I now ask Conseiller William Raymond if he wishes to speak in support of the candidate.

Conseiller William Raymond: Briefly, sir, yes please.

Today I am proposing Lt. Col. Reginald Guille for the post of Speaker.

30 Reg, as we all know him, returned to Sark after a distinguished military career. His working connection with Chief Pleas is well known and culminated in his appointment to Seneschal and President of Chief Pleas, where he did so much for the dignity of that office.

He then took the role of President, now Speaker, when the judiciary was split from the legislature. I am delighted to think that he has not lost his appetite for Island work and that he is prepared to offer himself today.

Conseiller Sandra Williams, do you wish to add anything?

The Seneschal: Ladies and gentlemen, Conseillers, can I have your attention.

The Greffier, the Returning Officer, has concluded the vote. There are 6 votes for Arthur James Rolfe and 7 votes for Reginald John Guille. I therefore have to declare that Lt. Col. Reginald John Guille is elected as Speaker, as from the end of February.
