

## Examples of our work with schools:

#### Expanding A Levels at the British International School in Ukraine

In operation for 24 years, the British International School in Ukraine (BISU) is a COBIS-member school teaching the British curriculum across four campuses Kyiv and Dnipro.

Looking to broaden A Level subject options for their pupils, Principal David Cole actively searched for an outstanding and flexible course solution that complemented their existing subject offerings.

Working with King's InterHigh BISU's Sixth Form now offers additional A Level courses online, such as Further Maths; a subject that was in high demand.

# Expanding curriculum for a small school in Congo

A small, privately owned school in an affluent Congolese city recently came to King's InterHigh in need of a secondary curriculum.

However, student numbers were too small to justify the heavy investment and resourcing needed for a physical campus for secondary aged pupils.
