



**VISIT BY THEIR ROYAL HIGHNESSES THE EARL AND COUNTESS OF WESSEX-
TUESDAY, 10TH MAY 2022**

ITINERARY

- 12:25 Their Royal Highnesses arrive by helicopter and land at the west end of the Millennium Field. A reception party of the Seigneur Major Christopher Beaumont and Mrs Sarah Beaumont, the Deputy Seneschal Ms Victoria Stamps, the Speaker of Chief Pleas Lieutenant Colonel Reg Guille MBE and Conseiller John Guille, will greet their Royal Highnesses. Miss Sark Princess, Robin Scott will present a small posy of flowers.
- 12.30 Their Royal Highnesses will deliver a message from Her Majesty the Queen.
- 12.35 Their Royal Highnesses will be asked to ceremonially plant a tree, as part of The Queen's Green Canopy. The Sark School Children will be gathered near the planting area.
- 12.40 Their Royal Highnesses will present Platinum Jubilee Medals to eligible members of the Sark Police, Sark Fire & Rescue Services and Sark Ambulance Service, to 20 recipients. The Sark Standard and Emergency Services Standard will be on parade.
- 13.00 Their Royal Highnesses will be escorted by the Seigneur and Mrs Beaumont to the Toplis Room, in the Island Hall, where they will be able to meet those Sark residents who were liberated in Sark or from Deportee Camps in Germany. Refreshments will be available.
- 13.20 The Seigneur and Mrs Beaumont will escort Their Royal Highnesses back to the helicopter, passing among the islanders gathered on the Millennium Field. In the gathering will be the visiting Chelsea In-Pensioners of The Royal Hospital, a party of Gurkha soldiers and a party of four WW2 Veterans.
- 13.30 Their Royal Highnesses depart by Helicopter. Prior to departure Their Royal Highnesses will be presented with a small basket of Sark produce by, Finley Southern and Henry Carré from Sark School.
