### **TRAVEL UPDATE AND INFORMATION FOR RESIDENTS**

The Bailiwick of Guernsey moved into stage three of exit from lockdown on the 22nd March 2021.

The Bailiwick “bubble” has been re-established and travel between the Islands is now unrestricted unless travelling from outside the Bailiwick..

In order to travel to Sark from outside the Bailiwick, travel must be approved by the PEC and arrangements made through the Committee. The cargo boat is able to carry four passengers on Tuesdays & Thursdays and leaves Guernsey at 8am.

Due to the restricted numbers, we strongly advise travellers to book travel at least three weeks in advance and would also recommend that travellers arrive in Guernsey on Mondays and Wednesdays in order to minimise time spent in isolation in Guernsey.

The Committee can arrange private charters for travellers arriving from outside of the Bailiwick only, with a maximum of four passengers on Tuesday and Thursday afternoons, weather and tides permitting, however the cost will be the responsibility of the traveller.

Travellers coming to Sark from outside the Bailiwick are still subject to isolation regulations, with a test on arrival and a test on day 13. If a test is not taken, then travellers are required to isolate for 21 days. Once a negative test result has been received or isolation completed, travellers are free to resume normal life.
