2025/2026 Sark Ormering Dates and Tides

In accordance with the Ordinance of the Chief Pleas entitled "The Fishinq (Sark) Ordinance, 1996"

5. (1) A person shall not in this Island take, have in his possession, buy, sell or offer for sale ormers, other than preserved ormers, at any time except on the day of each new moon and on the **three days** next following and on the day of each full moon and on the three days next following during the period commencing on the tenth day of October in each year and ending on the thirtieth day of April next following, both days inclusive:

October 21st,22nd,23rd,24th
November 5th,6th,7th,8th,20th,22nd,23rd
December 4th,5th,6th,7th,20th,21st,22nd,23rd
January 3rd, 4th, 5th,6th, 18th, 19th, 20th,21st
February 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 17th, 18th, 19th, 20th
March 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th,19th, 20th, 21th, 22nd
April 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 17th, 18th, 19th, 20th

- Gathering of ormers is permitted only on the day of each new or full moon, and the three days following, between 1 January and 30 April.
- It is an offence to take, land or possess ormers which are less than 8cm in breadth.
- It is an offence to take ormers at night.
