Leadership Program Work Group

- Rule 6A-5.081, F.A.C., states that the department shall have a continued approval site visit process for leadership programs.
- Through a partnership with the Wallace
 Foundation, a work group will develop a site review
 process for state-approved Level 1 and Level 2
 programs, with a focus on the following:
 - Examining current practices in leadership preparation programs;
 - Strengthening partnerships;
 - Strengthening programs; and
 - Finalizing a continued approval process.

REVIEW



Leadership Program Work Group

Design, Implement, Review and Recommend

Through June 2022

The work group designs a site visit review process for state-approved Level 1 and Level 2 programs.

July-September 2022

The work group conducts site visits at three institutions of higher education and three school districts.

By December 2022

The work group makes recommendations to establish a process for leadership program continued approval.

October-December 2022

The work group meets to review the process, reflect on learnings and data, and determine next steps.

Initial Development Plan

 Proposed draft standards containing a common set of standards with descriptors differentiated along a leadership continuum.

Also, skills and behaviors identified for the growth and development of **teacher leaders** were indicated within the assistant principal descriptors.

Requires school districts to implement an evaluation procedure for instructional personnel and school-based administrators.
Aspiring leaders, assistant principals and principals	Section 1012.56, F.S., Public accountability and state approval of school leader preparation programs	Rule 6A-5.080, F.A.C. Rule 6A-5.081, F.A.C.	Authorizes certain entities to create leadership preparation programs resulting in certification.
	Section 1012.55, F.S., Positions for which certificates are required	Rule 6A-4.082, F.A.C. Rule 6A-4.083, F.A.C.	Outlines requirements for obtaining educational leadership and school principal certifications.
Teacher leaders, assistant principals, principals, and district-based leaders	Section 1012.986, F.S., William Cecil Golden Professional Development Program for School Leaders	Potential future rule development	Establishes a collaborative professional learning network for educational leaders.



2021 Policy Updates


- Section 1012.986, F.S., amended to focus on "educational leaders," defined as teacher leaders, assistant principals, principals or school district leaders.
- Updated professional learning priorities to include:
 - Student achievement and learning
 - Civic education
 - Coaching and mentoring
 - Mental health awareness
 - Technology in education
 - Distance learning
 - School safety



What's Next?

Rule Development

- Spring 2022
 - Revision of Florida Principal Leadership Standards to delineate between expectations for assistant principals and principals
 - Connected to evaluation systems and leadership certification programs





What's Next?

Rule Development

- Timeframe TBD
 - Development of new rule to administer section 1012.986, F.S.
 - Creation of accompanying guidance to support professional learning for teacher leaders and district-based instructional leaders
