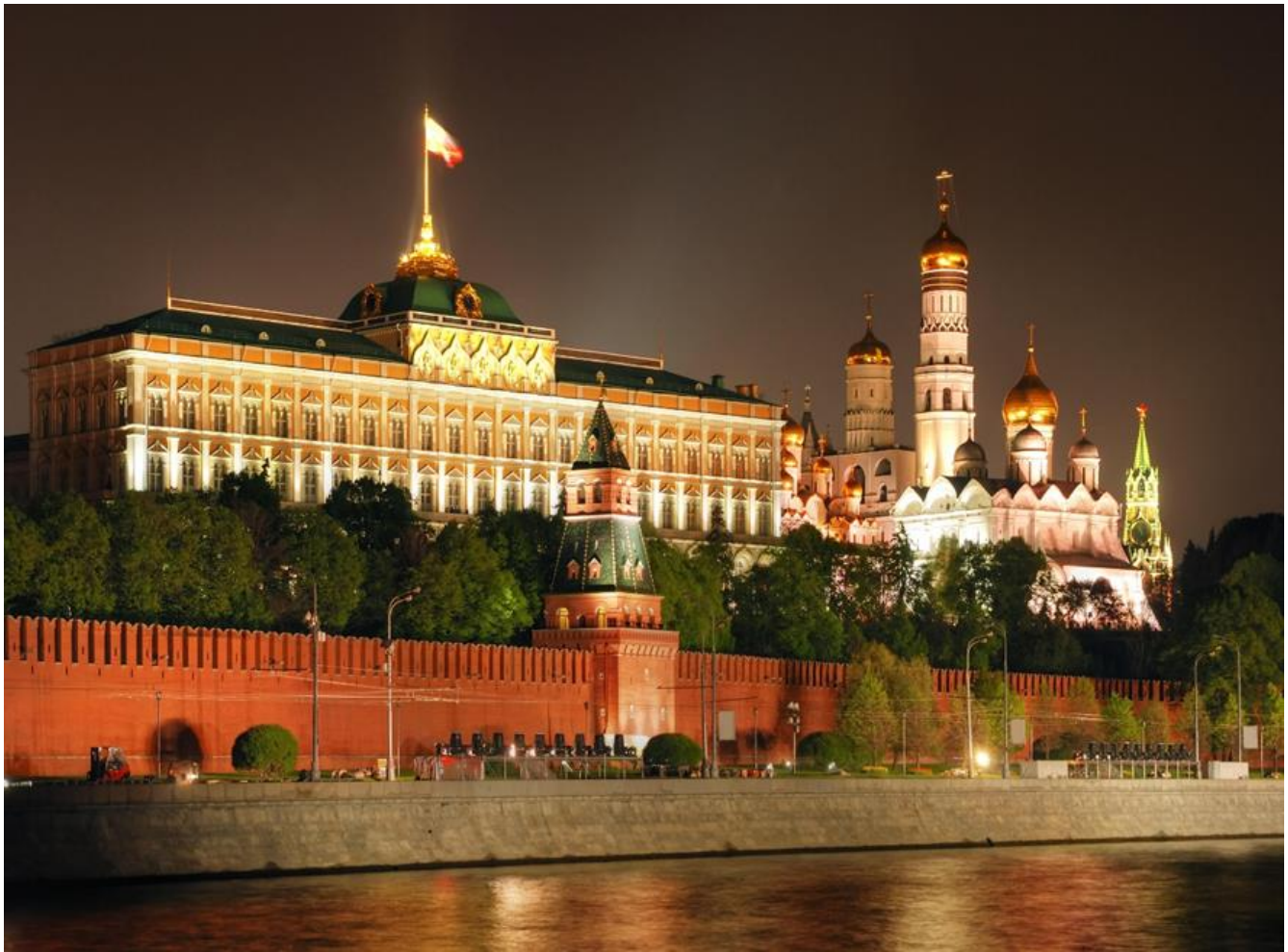

Frank and Catherine newly married are living in Texas, but before starting their family on their 100-acre ranch in San Luis Potosi, Mexico, they hit a brick wall. America's President unexpectedly dies from cancer, and Dmitry Melnikoff is sworn in as President of the United States. Frank desperately wants to conceive their first child regardless of who is living in the White House. Catherine convinced Frank to become a father, but suddenly can't make good on the promise because of who is living in the White House. Frank and Catherine don't know if they are up to the challenge. Never-the-less they put into motion America's second civil war to forcefully remove Dmitry Melnikoff from power, and hopefully save their marriage. The couple's treacherous path led straight to the White House, the beast's lair...

Six months pass after Dmitry Melnikoff becomes President of the United States, as massive riots break out in every major U.S. city. Nationwide "Martial Law" leads to Catherine working again with Ex-CIA agent Danny Boy, and the President of Mexico Miguel Gutierrez, to convince America's closest NATO allies to come to her rescue. Frank uses his new position, Secretary of the Interior, as cover, enlisting eight key state Governors in standing up the United States Militia, and puts General Mackay together with Guantanamo imprisoned Bill Henderson, Commander of NORTHCOM, to lead America's resistance movement. The emotions fly between Frank and Catherine as Catherine's mother reveals she has serious health issues, and her only wish is to hold her grandchild in her arms, just once before she passes. We see the leader of the resistance, General Mackay's tumultuous internal struggle to take up

arms against U.S. military personnel. We also witness Private Pete Wilson's personal turmoil, stationed at Fort Jackson, South Carolina. A loyalist, he believes that he must carry out every order he is given to uphold the oath he took upon joining the U.S. military, but sleepless nights ensue thanks to his killing of U.S. citizens, and he secretly contemplates joining the resistance.

The U.S. coup begins first with the sealing of America's four geographic borders. West Coast U.S. Militia backed by Australian troops and naval power secure the western flank. Southwest U.S. Militia backed by Mexican troops secure the southern flank.

Northern U.S. Militia backed by British troops and air power secure the northern front. Eastern U.S. Militia backed by French troops secure the Eastern front. Japan and Germany play defense at high sea with Russian submarines and battleships containing them in the Arctic, North Atlantic, and China Sea.

Tip of the spear Illinois, Indiana, Ohio, Michigan, New York, Pennsylvania, Virginia, North Carolina, South Carolina, and Kentucky Militia fight long protracted battles while slowly making their advance on the capitol suffering massive casualties. U.S. Military personnel moral plummets, after killing hundreds of thousands of their fellow Americans.

President Dmitry Melnikoff threatens to use biological weapons on American protestors, whom he deems traitors. Hundreds of thousands of gold bars are reported missing from Fort Knox. Thousands of Americans are arrested under suspicion of espionage. President Dmitry Melnikoff threatens all out nuclear war if he is not obeyed by all NATO members. But one man in the White House saves the world from nuclear destruction when he flees the White House and hand delivers the all-important U.S. nuke detonation box which doesn't even require firing codes to General Mackay. The White House traitor was mysteriously poisoned a week after accomplishing his daring deed. His family flees to Canada under assumed identities. The nuclear stand-off between General Mackay, and President Dmitry Melnikoff is reminiscent of the Cuban Missile Crisis, and after much drama they choose to

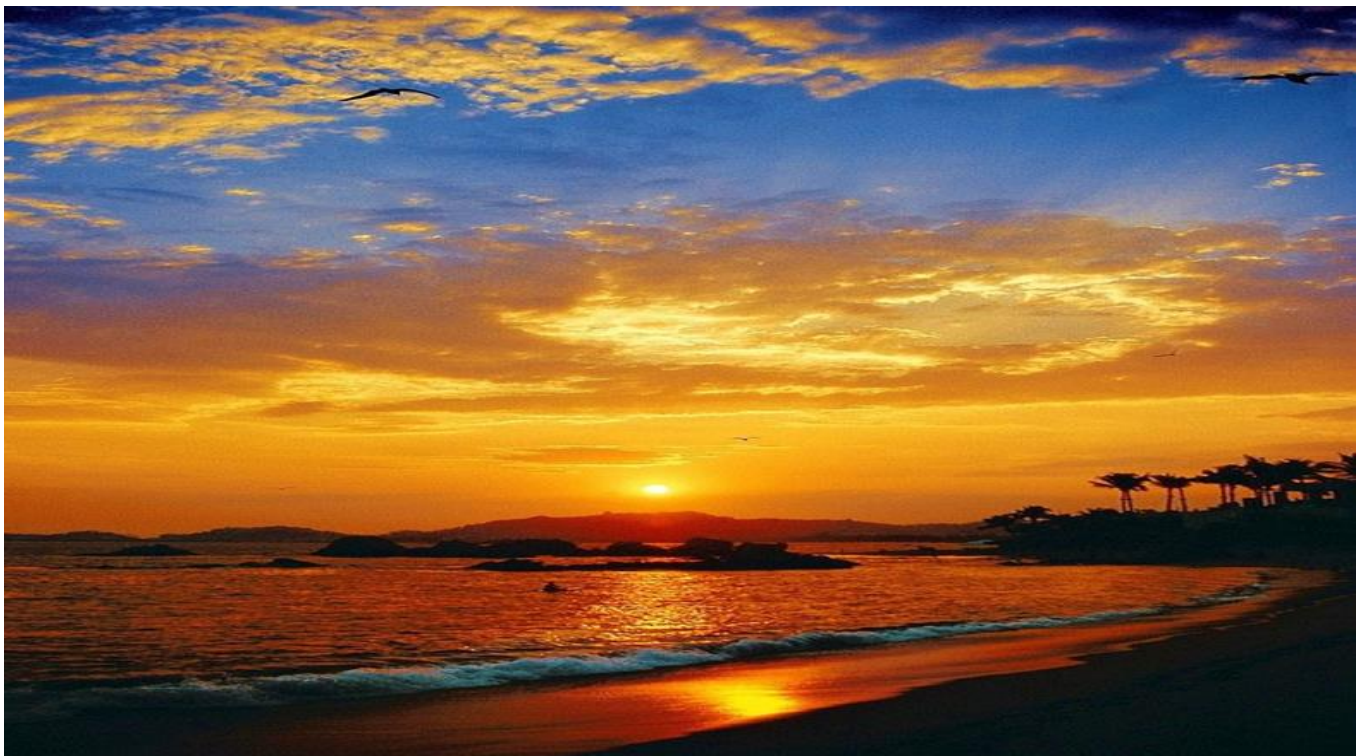
stand down in a stalemate.

Supporters mourning the sudden, tragic passing of their beloved President secretly decide to join the ranks of the U.S. militia, dramatically changing the coup's chances for success. Mexico, The U.K, France, Germany, and Australia outperform expectations when an unexpected surprise pushes the U.S. Militia over the top. As U.S. Military personnel morale plummets further and American blood soaks into American soil, a surprise is at hand. Unbeknown to General Mackay, Militia in the hundreds of thousands have shown up unannounced on the front lines from the states of Colorado, Florida, Georgia, Texas, and South Carolina. The reinforced, now enlarged Militia fights long protracted battles slowly making their advance on the nation's capital suffering massive casualties but gaining ground daily.

Frank and Catherine execute their bold plan flawlessly, and Dmitry Melnikoff is forced to return to Russia with his tail between his legs, vowing revenge on the American people. This victory unites the country. Republicans, Democrats, and Independents in a new found sense of American patriotism, find a way to peacefully coexist. A female American President is elected after a three-month campaign season, and begins the arduous task of burying the dead, and healing the greatest democratic country on earth, the United States of America.

But the viewer worries, does Frank's and Catherine's marriage survive the ordeal? Is their failed marriage simply a cost of doing business in the restoring of America's sovereignty?
