Mr. Sherick began importing parts from the UK, as well as continuing to supply used parts, and he soon began to advertise throughout the United States - and British Parts Northwest came into being. Having moved up through the ranks so to speak, Mr. Sherick knew what it was like to be out looking for parts and he focused on keeping prices low and providing efficient, fast, and courteous service to his customers. That practice is still employed by British Parts Northwest at their current facility located on 40 acres in rural Dayton, Oregon. They've been there since 1986. It is a family operated corpora-

tion today that provides new parts for British cars: Triumph, MG, Jaguar, Classic Mini, Land Rover, and Austin Healey.
